

# CHECKING OUT THE LIBRARIAN

After 35 years, 60 Spine Tingles sessions, 208 Isaian book review articles, 776 contest competitors, their 14,172 book reports, countless class library visits, and the creation of a digital catalog numbering almost 7000 volumes; I retire as Temple Isaiah's Librarian.

The Library is not the same place I entered as a traffic refugee in 1980, then as Librarian in 1984. I updated the library cataloging system from drawers of index cards to a digital network that was searchable on desktops and laptops. I am proud of every entry from number 1 to 6968. Not all numbers are gains. We went from two doors to one when the women's bathroom enlarged, from two file cases to zero and from center bookcases dedicated to children and young adults to only wall shelves around the room. We lost shelves to the television screen.

The physical changes never changed my relationship to you the Isaiah community. You made my day when I found the right read for a vacation, a Havurah session, or a classroom project. I kvelled making you happy when a book request was quickly in your hands. The best was watching your children compete to read and to learn about the various topics that changed with the annual Reading Contests.

Through my professional Jewish Library Association, I was able to spread the name of Temple Isaiah's Levine Library from coast to coast. At the 350th Anniversary of Jews in America I developed a monthly book program that swept chronologically through our experiences from prerevolutionary days to the present. Synagogue libraries across the country purchased this program; their fees helped buy us more history books. I speak at regional and national conferences, write reviews of adult and children's books for journals (garnering free library books in return), and serve as a judge for national book awards as the Librarian of Temple Isaiah, Los Angeles. I am proud of my major Jewish Librarian awards, one national, one local, that I received as your Librarian.



It is hard to say goodbye; we will stay in touch. I leave you an accredited Synagogue library with a sound budget plus money in two library funds supported all these years faithfully by generous Temple members. I look forward to seeing you as a volunteer with the Spine Tingles Book Club, at educational programs, services, and joyous occasions. To all of you, I give my never overdue date-stamp of approval, my gratitude, and my love.
