



PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Temple Isaiah, a community organization, is a place for the entire family. We welcome you to the preschool and hope you take advantage of all the special programs the Preschool and Temple have to offer you and your family.

Program Name	Program Description
Teddy Bears (1 year olds)	This is a class for children 12 months and older by September 1 and is attended with a parent or caregiver. Children are grouped by age and meet 1 day per week. Program includes play, music, snack, stories and parent education.
Guppies & Tadpoles (2 year olds)	This innovative program is for children who are 2 years old by September 1. This is a great way to introduce your child to the preschool. Parents can enroll their child 2 (T Th) or 3 (MWF) days per week. Once the children have transitioned, they will have the option of enrolling to stay until 2:30 p.m. Home visits are optional for children who may benefit from a home-based interaction with the teachers.
Beautiful Butterflies (2.9 year olds)	Children who turn 3 between July and December have the option of enrolling 3 to 5 days a week. This is a more structured class which features many of the same components as Guppies and Tadpoles, but is for the child who is ready to attend school without a parent or caregiver and is closer to three-years of age. This class meets from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. with the option of staying until 2:30 p.m.
Hungry Caterpillar, Red Caboose & Yellow Submarine (3 year olds)	These three classes are for children who are at least 3 years old by September 1. They can enroll 3 to 5 days per week, until 12:00 or 2:30 p.m.
Preschool Enrichment (3 year olds)	This is an optional program for children in any of the three year old classes. Children can stay until 2:30 any or all days of the week. Snacks, playtime and enrichment are provided. Enrichment classes include sports, yoga, art, phonics, cooking, Judaica, music, dance, etc.
Cruising Comets, Glittery Galaxy, Golden Sun, Mighty Meteors & Racing Rockets (4 year olds)	This is a pre-kindergarten program for children who have completed one year of preschool. Children can enroll 4 or 5 days per week. All children must attend mandatory days on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays and stay until 2:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Fridays are optional until 12:00 or 2:30 p.m. The mandatory late days are essential for proper preparation for Kindergarten. They also ensure that children are provided with developmentally appropriate activities in addition to the Judaic and enrichment components of the program.
Silver Moon & Shooting Stars (4-5 year olds)	These classes are unique in that they provide children an additional year of preschool in our nurturing environment while preparing them for the transition to either kindergarten or first grade, depending on the individual child's age and school readiness. Most children in this class have their fifth birthday between August and January. Children can enroll for 4 or 5 days per week. The schedule is the same as the other Pre-K classes.
Pre-K Enrichment (4-5 year olds)	This is a program for children in the Pre-K classes for the optional Tuesday and Friday 12:00-2:30 program. Children will have a creative and academic enrichment program of art, sports, science and math, culminating with special evening exhibits and fairs to show their progress.
