

PROGRAMS & PRICING 2023-2024

We are excited to offer several pathways you can choose for your child to learn with us and engage in our community. Each of these pathways can be chosen as an individual experience or can be paired with other pathways to create a unique and robust set of learning and engagement opportunities for your children. Below are more detailed descriptions of our pathways.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Jewish holidays, lifecycle events, Torah stories, Israel, and Jewish values. Every class participates in a beautifully designed musical T'filah service. Students learn basic Hebrew, prayers, and blessings. The Hebrew Through Movement curriculum is one of the ways we practice the new vocabulary that is being taught.

- When: Sunday mornings from 9:30am-12:00pm
- Who: Students in PreK to 6th grade
- Cost: \$1,600 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

POP-UP CHOIR

Temple Isaiah's Pop-Up Choir will be popping up every week! Does your child love to sing and perform? The choir will meet every week when Sunday School is in session to learn songs, have fun and get ready to performs for the High Holidays, Simchat Torah, Hanukkah, Shabbat and more. Come for a pizza lunch and fun singing with Cantor Schloss and Sophie Feldman. Let the K12 Religious School office know you're interested and we will send you a sign-up form.

- When: Sundays when Religious School is in session from 12:00pm-12:45pm
- Who: Students in TK-6th grade
- Cost: No additional cost.

HEBREW INTENSIVE

The students in this class will have a speedy review of Hebrew letters and vowels and quickly dive into decoding practice using the text of prayers and blessings. Hebrew Intensive is an opportunity to go deeper in areas of Hebrew language acquisition and they will use games and Hebrew Through Movement to practice their skills. Jewish holidays vocabulary will be practiced in Hebrew and the children will see and hear the language as Israelis use it in different videos of celebrations and school conversations.

- When: Tuesday afternoons 4:00pm-6:00pm
- Who: Students in 4th-6th grades
- Cost: \$1,600 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)



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JUDAISM THROUGH MUSIC

After a successful first year, we are happy to offer this pathway for 4th, 5th and 6th graders to learn and be part of our community. This new and innovative program includes delving into Jewish values, history, liturgy, Torah stories, modern prayer, and community building through the unique lens of Jewish music.

- When: Tuesday afternoons 4:00pm-6:00pm
- Who: Students in 4th-6th grades
- Cost: \$1,600 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

HEBREW TUTORING 1-1

For students of all ages and grades, this program will pair one of our Hebrew tutors with your child and they will meet once a week – or more often, depending on your needs, for 30-minute sessions. Most of our students choose to meet on Zoom, but we do have availability for in-person sessions. This program is for students who need a bit of extra help in addition to the learning in class, for students who need extra help while preparing for Bar/Bat Mitzvah or for new students in grades 5th or 6th who have not had any prior Hebrew instruction.

- When: Tell us your availability. Different days/times available.
- Who: Students in all grades
- Cost: \$320/8 sessions. All sessions are 30 minutes long.

AFTER SCHOOL @ ISAIAH

A brand-new after-school learning and community building program: After School @ Isaiah. This weekly program gives children in TK-6th grades a safe and comfortable space in which to do homework, play with friends and enjoy a snack, followed by a variety of elective activities: Israeli dance, Hebrew Through Movement, Hebrew tutoring 1:1, Israeli & Jewish Cooking, Bibliodrama, and Jewish Arts & Crafts.

- When: Tuesday afternoons 1:30pm-6:00pm
 - 1st Trimester 13 weeks \$780 (August 22-November 28)
 - 2nd Trimester 10 weeks \$610 (December 5-February 27)
 - 3rd Trimester 10 weeks \$610 (March 5-May 28)
- Who: Students in TK-6th grades
- Cost: 3 Trimesters. Price listed above + a one-time \$75 K12 Security and RSPA Fee



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TEEN SCHOOL

This is our Religious School programming for 7th to 12th graders. All teens enjoy dinner together (a favorite part of the program) as they spend time together and socialize with friends. The curriculum touches on Jewish values, allows students to go deeper in their understanding of the Holocaust (using the Facing History and Ourselves curriculum) and offers students the opportunity to learn about (and practice) Jewish philanthropy.

- When: Tuesday evenings 6:00pm-8:00pm
- Who: Students in 7th to 12th grade
- Cost: \$1,850 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)
- 10th, 11th & 12th grade class is 16 weeks only. Cost is \$1350 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

JUNIOR RISHONIM

Teens in grades 7th-9th are encouraged to apply for the Junior Rishonim program. They are invited to do any/all the following:

- 1. Help run the After School @ Isaiah program on Tuesday afternoons. Supervise younger children with homework and free play and help run all the activities of this program.
- 2. Helpers in the Sunday morning religious school classes.
- 3. Be junior counselors during the 4th-6th grades weekend retreat.
- 4. Be junior counselors during Temple Isaiah's Family Camp
- When: Tuesday afternoons 1:30pm-6:00pm and/or Sunday 9:30am-12:00pm
- Who: Students in 7th-9th grade
- Cost: No cost! This is a volunteer program. Teens will receive credit for their hours to be used as needed for school service hours

RISHONIM FELLOWSHIP

Teens in grades 10th-12th are invited to apply to the Rishonim Fellowship. Rishonim participate on Sunday mornings and/or Tuesday afternoons, supporting teachers in our classrooms or assisting in the school office. Fellows attend several professional development sessions and receive a generous stipend, thanks to Gail Solo and the Gail Solo Youth Opportunity Scholarship Fund that underwrites this program.

- When: Sunday mornings 9:15am-12:15pm and/or Tuesdays 1:30pm-6:00pm
- Who: Students in 10th-12th grades
- Cost: No cost! Rishonim will receive a \$2000 stipend.
